În perioada, 27.11.2017-02.12.2017, am participat la cursul de formare continuă care s-a desfășurat în Vasto, Italia, în cadrul proiectului Erasmus + KA1, "Merg la școală, reușesc!".

Cursul a fost intitulat "Inclusive teaching, family and social cousenlling for disadvantaged students and in order to prevent the early dropout".

Acest curs și-a propus să dezvolte abilitățile și competențele profesorilor de a crea instrumente educaționale eficiente pentru a răspunde nevoilor elevilor, pentru integrarea elevilor în școală și pentru a preveni abandonul timpuriu.

Obiectivele cursului au fost:

O1: să cunoască caracteristicile unei școli incluzive;

O2: să cunoască tehnicile de gestionare optimă a clasei;

O3: să efectuăm o pedagogie incluzivă;

O4: să cunoască și să folosească tehnologiile în educația incluzivă, să utilizeze hărțile în procesul de învățare;

O5: să știe cum să faciliteze procesele de comunicare și să dezvolte competențe emoționale între cadre didactice, elevi, părinți pentru a crește motivația școlară și stima de sine;

O6: să știe cum să promoveze continuitatea educației și a predării.

Programul activităților a fost următorul:

În prima zi, s-a prezentat, în linii mari, structura cursului, obiectivele acestuia și cadrele didactice formatoare. Am aflat caracteristicile unei școli incluzive. Sunt adaptate creativ metode și mijloace astfel încât să contribuie la dezvoltarea personală a elevilor și la succesul lor. Au fost desfășurate activități privind dezvoltarea inteligențelor multiple, intrapersonală și interpersonală. Au fost efectuate exerciții pe care le putem aplica în activitățile extracurriculare.

A doua zi, ne-am întâlnit cu directorul și profesorii unei școli din Vasto. Accentul a fost pus pe tehnicile utilizate în predarea incluzivă și pe consilierea familială. Au fost utilizate strategii didactice variate în

concordanță cu caracteristicile grupului de elevi, facilitând învățarea. Lecții atractive, strategii diverse, rolul profesorului fiind de a crea o clasă pozitivă.

Incluziunea în educație este văzută ca o politică globală care prescrie dezvoltarea spre o școală obișnuită care salută toți elevii cu caracteristicile individuale, interesele, abilitățile și nevoile lor de învățare, toți copiii cu și fără nevoi speciale și handicap.

A treia zi, a fost prezentată metoda Feldenkrais (metodă de motricitate) și tehnicile de învățare - predare care să contribuie la dezvoltarea personală a elevilor și la succesul lor. Am înțeles că trebuie să regândim învătarea

orientată către noi abordări pedagogice, să dezvoltăm și să întărim conștientizarea elevilor asupra propriului proces de învățare, jucând un rol activ în el. Este important să ne dezvoltăm o imagine de sine pozitivă. Am colaborat și comunicat cu profesorul de sprijin. O școală incluzivă trebuie să asigure dreptul la educație al tuturor elevilor, tinând cont de caracteristicile specifice ale fiecăruia.

În cea de-a patra zi, au fost puse în evidență efectele comunicării și dezvoltarea competențelor emoționale între cadre didactice, elevi și părinți pentru a crește motivația școlară și stima de sine. Accentul a fost pus pe tehnicile și strategiile de reducere a nivelului de conflict și stres (teatrul invizibil; ce este teatrul persoanelor stresate?). Instrumente pentru dezvoltarea capacității elevilor de a gândi, recunoaște și pune în cuvinte emoțiile care stau la baza experiențelor dureroase: abordarea multi-senzorială.

În ziua a cincea, ne-am întâlnit cu directorul și profesorii unei școli gimnaziale din Vasto, Italia. Au fost purtate discuții privind utilizarea tehnicilor familiale și sociale pentru elevii defavorizați (consiliere familială și socială). Au fost prezentate tehnici și strategii privind integrarea elevilor cu deficiențe, nevoi de învățare și handicap în clasa colaborativă: discuții cu profesorul clasei și profesorul de sprijin. S-au discutat și analizat cazurile speciale; studii de caz.

În cea de-a șasea zi, ultima, au fost colectate feedback-urile finale. Am vizitat orașul Vasto și zona învecinată, Abruzzo pentru a descoperi arta, tradițiile, istoria, natura, alimentele tipice zonei.

Centrul de formare Polaris ne-a oferit o cină de rămas bun, după care au fost acordate certificatele de participare.

Prin urmare, o școală incluzivă trebuie să asigure dreptul la educație al tuturor elevilor, ținând cont de caracteristicile specifice ale fiecăruia.

Cursul a fost foarte bine structurat, iar obiectivele au fost îndeplinite cu succes.

Relația formator - cursant s-a bazat pe colaborare, comunicare și respect reciproc.

Formatorii au dovedit amabilitate, generozitate, responsabilitate, profesionalism. Atmosfera de lucru fiind caldă, prietenoasă, alături de oameni sociabili.
